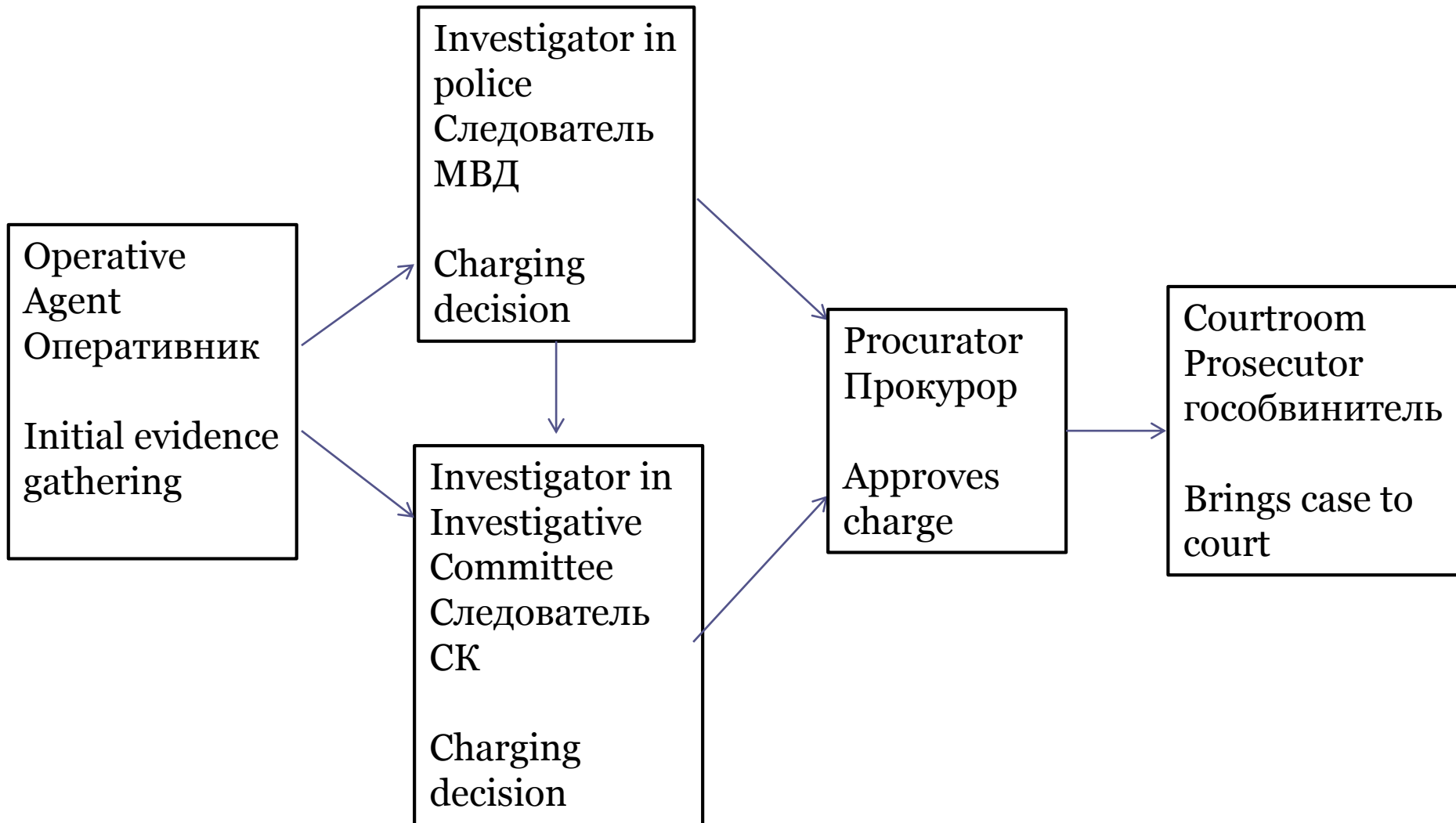

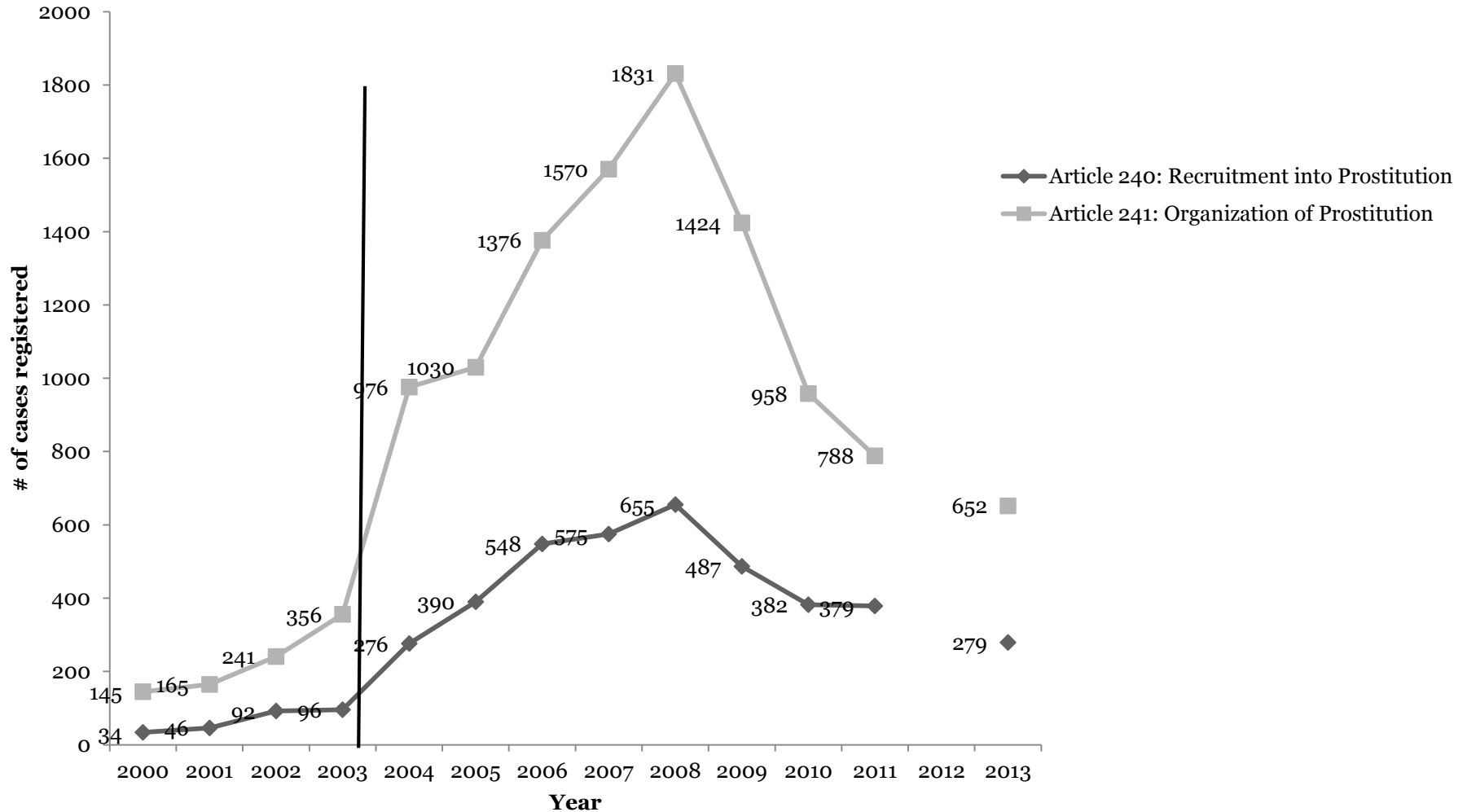

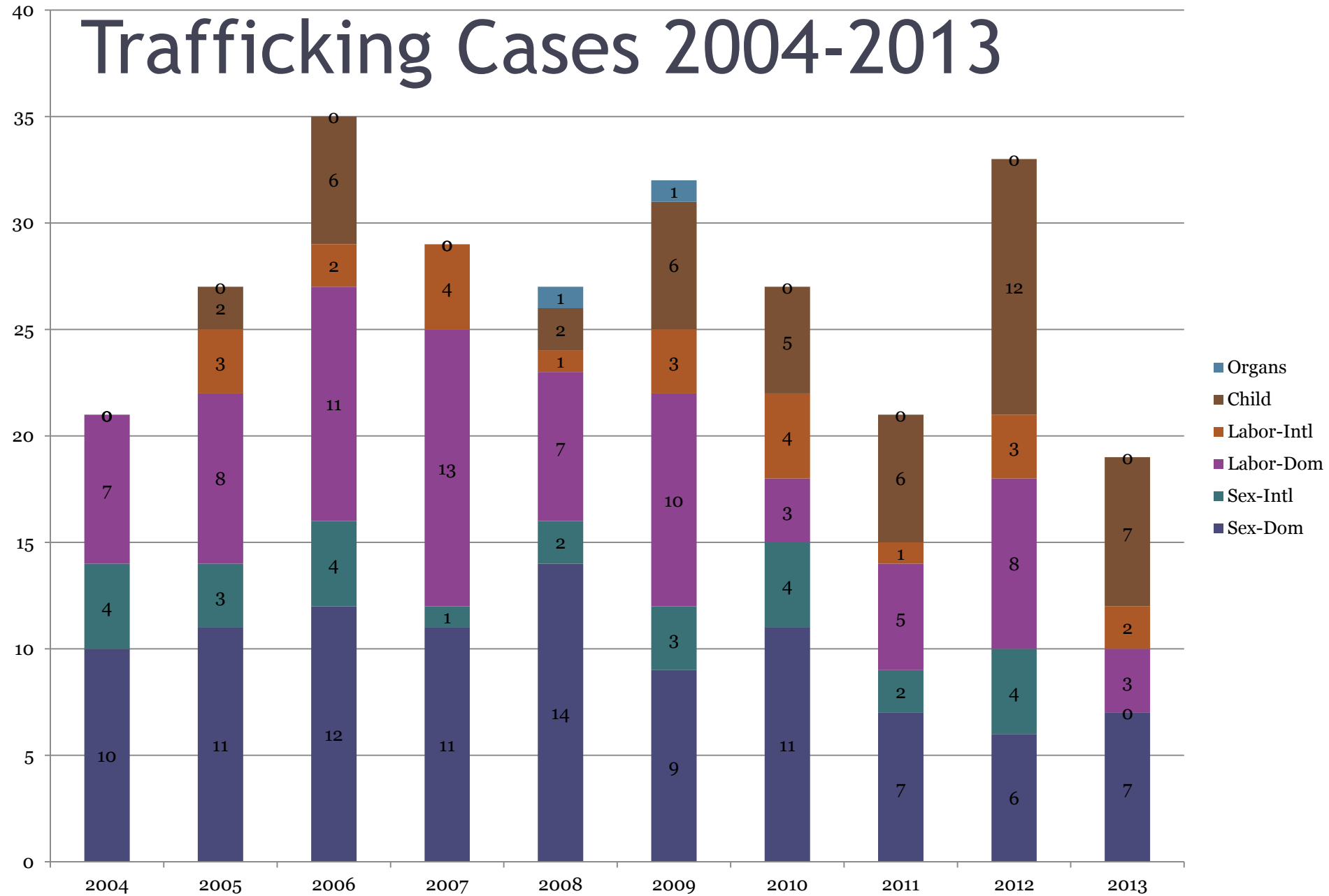

- Interviews with non-government organizations and academics
- Participant observation at conferences and at the International Organization for Migration
- Database of over 5,200 Russian newspaper articles on human trafficking cases
- Documents from 102 court cases
